



Following are the characteristics of an ash tree.



Ash trees, have broad leaves, as shown here.

Ash trees, have compound leaves, or multiple leaf on one stem as shown here.

Ash tree leaves are opposite, meaning there is a leaf directly opposite or mirrored on the other side of the stem as shown here.
